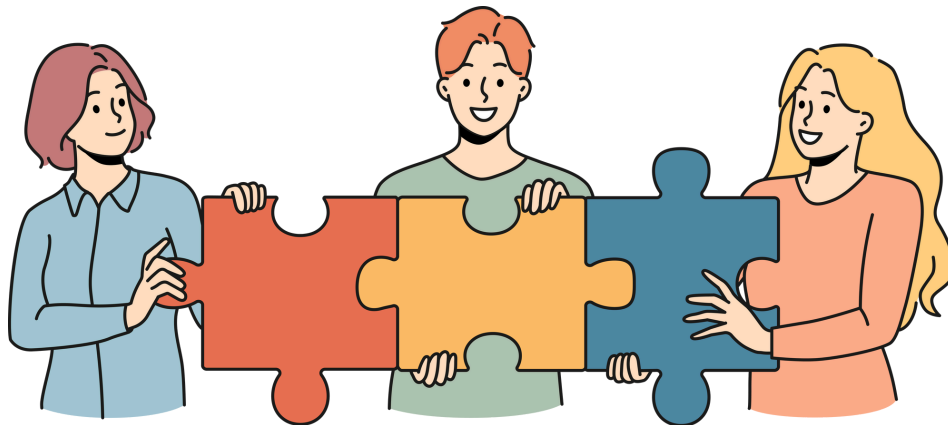


# PROJECT SUCCESS

Project SUCCESS (Schools Using Coordinated Community Efforts to Strengthen Students) was listed on SAMHSA's National Registry of Evidence-based Programs and Practices. Project SUCCESS is a program that prevents and reduces substance use and abuse among high risk, multi-problem adolescents placed in alternative schools and high-risk students in regular secondary schools. It works by placing highly trained professionals (Project SUCCESS counselors) in the schools to provide a full range of substance abuse prevention and early intervention services.

Project SUCCESS utilizes the following prevention strategies: School-wide prevention awareness campaigns; Classroom prevention education; Screening, Referral, Prevention groups; and substance use prevention policies.
