

LifeSkills Training Program: School Commitment Form



Curriculum materials provided by the SD Tobacco Control Program

A school-based curriculum that has shown evidence of preventing the initiation of tobacco, such as LifeSkills, is a vital part of comprehensive tobacco prevention program. The SD Tobacco Control Program can provide LifeSkills curricula materials to schools in South Dakota.

Schools requesting LifeSkills curricula must have LifeSkills-trained teachers and a school administrator's written commitment to implement the curricula as designed on the enclosed School Commitment form. All of the LifeSkills lessons, pursuant to the level of materials requested, must be implemented for at least one full school year. Participants must provide the SD Tobacco Control Program the number of students by grade level that received the prevention education (yearly aggregate information).

LifeSkills teacher trainings are sponsored through a joint effort by the SD Departments of Health and Social Services; at these trainings you are provided either Elementary Level 1 or Middle School Level 1 curricula materials. If a teacher has been trained in one level of LifeSkills, that teacher can teach all levels of the curricula.

The SD Tobacco Control Program will provide additional LifeSkills materials, including teacher manuals and student workbooks. **Availability of materials through the SD Tobacco Control Program is dependent on available funding and demonstrated need.**

If you would like to request additional LifeSkills curricula materials from the Tobacco Control Program, you may do so by:

1. Requesting the number of manuals and student workbooks needed for each class at the LifeSkills levels you wish to teach, on the School Commitment Form.
2. Submitting the completed School Commitment Form. A school administrator must review the terms and sign the form.

Please mail or scan and email your completed form to Tynell Millner (contact information provided on the form). The materials requested will be shipped directly to you from *Princeton Health Press*. Even though you receive a *Princeton Health Press* order form in your packet, you do not need to fill that form out if you wish to request materials from the SD Tobacco Control Program.

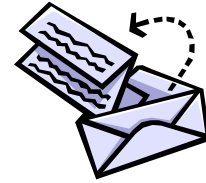
All orders will be shipped directly to the school address noted on the form via UPS (Please note: UPS cannot ship to PO Boxes).
